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Getting started

Welcome!

Congratulations on beginning your mentoring journey as a mentor, mentee or both! Watch [this video](#) to learn a little more about mentoring and Mentorloop.

This guide will provide the basics on navigating the platform, what features to look out for and provide you with some resources/tips to make your mentoring experience even better!

Signup Process

You will have received a link to register to your mentoring program. Upon clicking this link, you'll be directed to a signup page that will ask you to complete some questions. These cover aspects about you, your career, and most importantly, what you hope to contribute or achieve through your mentoring experience.

Once completed, your sign up form becomes your profile in the program, giving potential mentoring connections a glimpse into who you are. We recommend you [update your profile](#) and keep it up to date - as it helps others get to know you better and also plays a role in the matching process.

For some programs, the Program Coordinator may need to approve your application. Just wait for the confirmation email. If you don't receive it, reach out to your Program Coordinator.

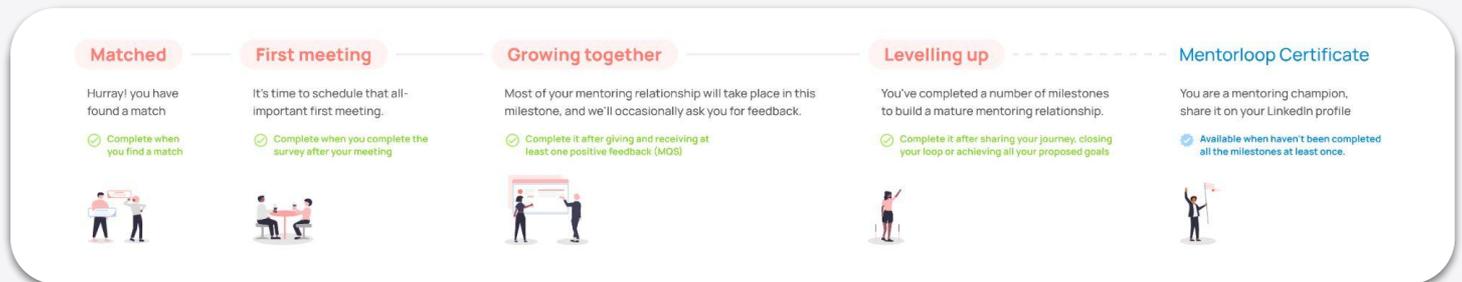
We aim to complement the natural and organic mentoring that may already be happening.

Loop-based Milestones

Once you have been found your mentoring match, the Mentorloop Milestones are a series of stages that will guide you through your mentoring relationship. The milestones automatically moves you along depending on the interactions you have with your match.

Matching

Manual or Algorithm Match

Based on your program, your Program Coordinator may have already assigned you a match, either *manually* or through the Mentorloop Algorithm.

What is the Algorithm?

It takes into account factors such as your skills, experience, location etc. If this is the case, you will receive an email notification regarding your match.

We recommend reaching out to your match to say hello and kick off your mentoring relationship!

Self Match

Alternatively, you may have the option of finding your own match within the program. You can explore potential matches via the left sidebar of Mentorloop under Find a Match and request to connect.

Communication

Your Coordinator Loop

If you have a question that is related to the particular management of your mentoring program, it's probably best suited to your Program Coordinator.

You have direct access to your Program Coordinator/s via your 1:1 loop, which you can access by clicking "Your Coordinator" from the left navigation bar of your dashboard

1:1 Loop

Once you are matched, you will have access to a 1:1 Loop with your mentor/mentee.

A Loop is essentially a journal of your mentoring relationship, from where you can communicate with your match, [schedule meetings](#), [launch Zoom calls](#), [share files](#) and [set goals](#).

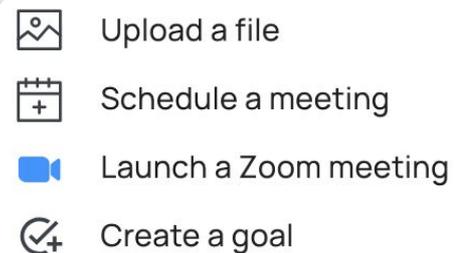
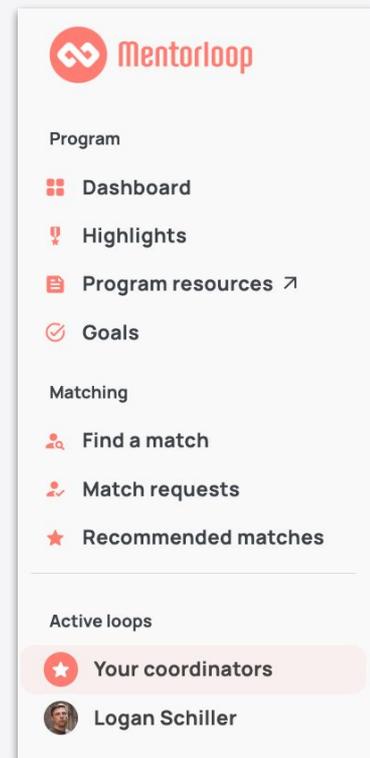
Over time, the Loop becomes an online journal of your mentoring experience, so be sure to keep a record of your mentoring meetings in there!

Your 1:1 loop is confidential. You can also [close your mentoring relationship from the 1:1 Loop](#).

Mentoring Agreement

We recommend setting expectations early on in your mentoring relationship. This adds structure and allows both the mentor and mentee to have a clear understanding of how your mentoring relationship will work.

The [mentoring agreement](#) will help you outline your mentoring expectations and set you up for success.



MENTORING AGREEMENT

This agreement exists to set your mentoring relationship up for success.

Document the who, how, why, and what of your mentoring plan early so you can get down to enjoying the reciprocal and potentially career-changing relationship with a new connection.

The full agreement and the fields are optional, but we recommend defining what success looks like upfront, so you can keep moving towards it together.

<p>Recording of Communication Who is in charge of sharing notes & next steps after each catch-up? <small>(We recommend the mentee drives the agenda, but every relationship is different.) Who will update statuses in Mentorloop?</small></p>	

Support

Nudges and notifications

As you begin your mentoring journey, Mentorloop will send communications throughout the first six months of your journey, followed by monthly communications.

These messages will be filled with valuable tips and tricks to keep the momentum going in your relationship.

Expect updates on new features, suggested articles to read and share with your mentoring match, as well as discussion points to enrich your mentoring meetings!

We recommend keeping an eye out for messages from your mentor, mentee or Program Coordinator.

Notifications are sent to your email if you are not logged into Mentorloop.

Feedback surveys

To provide participants with even more support, Mentorloop occasionally sends through a survey. We encourage you to share your feedback by completing survey, as it provides real time insights to your Program Coordinator.

This enables them to offer you additional support tailored to your needs. The survey includes:

1. **Mentoring Quality Score:** Sent every 60 days to gather feedback on your mentoring experience as it progresses
2. **Post-Meeting Survey:** Automatically sent if a meeting has been scheduled within the platform, capturing insights and reflections after each session
3. **Close Loop Survey:** [Triggered when a mentoring connection is closed](#), either by you or your Program Coordinator.

Your input is invaluable in ensuring the effectiveness of the program and overall experience!



Human Connection, The Start To An Effective Mentorship

For seasoned mentors and even mentees, understanding the key qualities of an effective mentor will enhance your mentoring experience! Discover the essential qualities and habits that make an effective mentor, many of which you may already have.
